Without limiting the foregoing: (1) unless the context of the clause or applicable law requires otherwise, the term "Contractor" shall mean Seller, the term "Contract" shall mean the Subcontract as that term is defined above, the term "Subcontractor" shall mean Seller's subcontractor, and the terms "Government," "Contracting Officer" and equivalent phrases shall mean SAIC and SAIC's Contractual Representative, respectively; (2) the words "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government; (3) where a clause specifies the number of days in which Seller must act, that number shall be reduced by half; and (4) where a clause specifies the number of days in which SAIC must act, that number shall be doubled.
